Albert (Al) passed away peacefully at Kaiser Permanente Hospital with his wife holding his hand. Al was born to John and Josephine Torretta in Richmond, CA. He was raised in Crockett and graduated from John Swett High School in 1952. He received an associate degree from the Mare Island apprentice program in 1956. In 1957 he left for Korea to serve for two years in the Army. Al worked at Mare Island for 39 years and retired as a Nuclear Inspection Supervisor in 1990. Soon after he began to work at Vallejo Stationers for ten years. Al was a member of Sons of Italy and NARFE.
