



Anselmo Anaviso Apayor Sr.

Anselmo Apayor Sr., 91, passed away on June 2, 2025 from a sudden illness. He was born in Maribohoc Bohol, Philippines to Dolores and Tito Apayor on April 21, 1934. He was the eldest of seven children and the last to reunite with his parents and siblings in the Kingdom of Heaven to Rest in Eternal Peace.

Anselmo, known to many as "Loloy", was the Patriarch of the Apayor Family. He married the love of his life, Belen, in 1961 and they were blessed with three children.
