



Catherine "Cathy" Ann Azevedo

July 28, 1937 - July 25, 2022

Catherine Ann Azevedo, 84, passed away on July 25, 2022, after a long battle with cancer. Catherine was born on July 28, 1937, to Edward and Catherine Giant in Vallejo, CA. After graduating from Vallejo High School, Catherine went on to attend the University of Southern California.

Catherine spent many years as a loving mother and even obtained a hunting license so that she could take her sons hunting. She worked at St. Patrick's High School and later was inducted into the St. Patrick's Hall of Fame where she almost single handedly orchestrated the completion of the athletic facilities. Catherine was the founder and first President of the Board of Regents and was a member of the School Board at St. Patrick's. She was also an active member of the committee to save Mare Island and later for the future planning of Mare Island. Catherine's steady career began late in life where she excelled as a financial advisor.

Although she would not be identified by the word "feminist", Catherine quickly rose through the ranks of her career through hard work and determination alone. Catherine was promoted to the first ever woman Branch Manager and Vice President for Prudential Securities. Catherine went on to become the first woman president, in its 118-year existence, of the Vallejo Chamber of Commerce. She also won the prestigious Athena award for her outstanding accomplishments in the community. Catherine retired at the age of 79. During her retired years, Catherine became inseparable with her beloved labradoodle, Lily.

Catherine is survived by her sons, Victor, Christopher (Denise), Stephen; brother, Edward; sister, Susan; grandchildren, Anthony (Chesiree), Joseph, Baylie; and great granddaughter, Anastasia.
