Kikuye Chrysanthia “Chrys” Narverud, 87, passed away gracefully Wednesday at her son’s home in Davis following a long illness. Anyone who knew her will not be surprised that she was spunky and enjoyed life up until her last day.

Chrys was born to Akira and Mataji Kubota on October 3, 1924 in San Francisco, CA. She lived for more than 50 years in Vallejo. For the last several years, she lived with her sons; first in Napa with her son Art, then in Davis with her son Rob.

Chrys was one of the pioneering doctors at Kaiser Permanente, where she worked for 29 years and was beloved by her many patients. She retired in 1987 to pursue her avid interests in golf and travel. As she made this transition, she continued to brighten the lives of those around her with her ebullient personality and unflinching sense of humor. Chrys thoroughly enjoyed life and had many other interests, including reading, opera, puzzles, bridge, dominos, the Olympics, art and dance. She was a long-time member of Chardonnay and Silverado golf clubs.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Raymond A. Narverud, MD; sisters, Miyuke Konagai and Kaoru Kitagawa; and grandson, Raymond M. Narverud.

Survivors include her sons, Arthur E. (Mary M.) Narverud and Robert A. (Vicki Link, MD) Narverud, MD; brother, Takashi "Tak" (Miyoko) Kubota; and granddaughter, Amber Narverud. She also leaves behind many beloved nieces, nephews, and their families.
