



## Eileen George Traynor

December 23, 1920 - June 18, 2021

Eileen was born and raised in Jersey City, NJ. She was the fourth child of seven in a large Irish Catholic family. After graduating from nurses training at Holy Name Hospital in Teaneck, NJ, Eileen enlisted in the U.S. Army Nurses Corp and spent three years in New Guinea & the Philippines during WWII. There she met and married our father Clarence George a life-long Vallejo resident. When they returned to the US after the war, they settled in Vallejo where they raised their five children.

Eileen worked as a registered nurse at Vallejo General Hospital from 1961-1980. She made many life-long friends, both through work as well as neighbors wherever she lived. Eileen was a kind and thoughtful woman who kept up her card writing to loved ones for most of her life. She loved to laugh and was a great storyteller.

She was a voracious reader and traveled extensively throughout the world. After her children were raised, Eileen spent much of her time with family on the East Coast. Every aspect of her life reflected her strong Catholic faith. As a parishioner of St. Basils' Church, she served as a volunteer and a member of the altar society.

In her later years, Eileen enjoyed a much quieter life with family and friends. She was still very interested in news of the world and politics. She was happy

to be able to vote in the November 2020 election.

Eileen will be greatly missed by all who loved her. She was preceded in death by her husbands: Clarence George, Jr & Bernard Traynor and her son Clarence III. She is survived by her children Alice (Connie), Elizabeth, Robert (Janet) and William (Vanessa), her stepchildren Bryan & Shawn Traynor, her 7 grandchildren & 8 great-grandchildren and her sisters Alice Mauriello & Joan O'Donoghue.

A funeral Mass will be held at St. Basil's Church, Vallejo at 1:00 pm July 10, 2021.
