Ernest "Ernie" Francis Heater, 85, passed away peacefully on April 28, 2013 at home in Vallejo after a brief illness. Ernie was born to Larry and Zeta (McDermott) Heater on February 21, 1928 in San Francisco.

Ernie worked as a Mechanical Engineering Technician at Mare Island Naval Shipyard for thirty-seven years. He graduated from St. Vincent's High School in 1947 and served in the U.S. Army.
