Felisa (Lily) Lapar Agot passed away peacefully at home in Vallejo on Wednesday, September 22, 2021 with her loving family at her bedside. She was 93 years old.

Lily was born in Tangub Ciy, Misamis Occidental, Philippines on April 23, 1928 to parents Crispiniano Lapar and Lucena Pacalioga and had four siblings. She attended Misamis University, Philippines, and had a degree in Home Economics.
