George Chris Gianulias, 85, passed away on Friday, November 25, 2016 at Queen of the Valley Hospital following a brief illness. Although suffering from Alzheimer's Disease, he still recognized his beloved wife Katherine (Bekas) Gianulias, of 61 years, and his loving family until the end.

A longtime resident of Vallejo, "Jumping George" was born and raised in Sacramento. After graduating from McClatchy High, he attended Sacramento JC where he attained his Associate Degree in Business. In 1955 he enrolled at Menlo College in Atherton, where he graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration, then attended the University of Southern California Graduate School of Business. Expanding his education, 1962-1964 he studied at Lincoln University Law School, also receiving his Real Estate Certificate from UC California Extension, completing his education in 1973 at JF Kennedy University with a Master's Degree in Business Administration, and received his Real Estate Broker and General Contractor licenses along the way.

Having numerous jobs while completing his education, including Vallejo Liquor Distributors, owned by Nick Bekas (father-in law) & AK Thannos, and opening

“Gay Puree” lounge in Vallejo. Working in Commercial Real Estate from 1955, his

employers consisted of United California Bank, Texaco, Alpha Beta-Acme Markets

and Safeway to name a few. His job descriptions included National Department

Manager of Real Estate Shopping Center development, site research, leases and

negotiations, eventually becoming self employed, owning, constructing and developing shopping centers. He owned, operated and built Vintage Bowl in American Canyon along with being instrumental in bringing Marine World to Vallejo with Terry Curtola.

He was preceded in death by his parents Chris & Nicoletta Gianulias, grandson Al and son-in-law Alfred Brown. He leaves behind a large beloved family including daughter’s Natalie Peretto (John) and Nikki, son Jimmy, grandchildren Katherine, Sherri, Sean, Jason and Jessica Brown, great granddaughter’s Allie & Sierra, brothers Andy, Gus, Jim, and Elaine Blomenberg, Marilyn Rollo. He lived for his family and enjoyed the numerous “Family Vacations” including many abroad visiting Greece, Africa, Europe, and South America.
