Harold E. "Boots" Kewley, 84, passed away Saturday at Queen of the Valley Medical Center in Napa following a brief illness with his family by his side.

Boots was born to Clarence and Pearl Kewley on September 27, 1926 in Alexandria, South Dakota. He was the 9th born from a family of 11 sisters and 4 brothers. Boots and his wife along with their 3 daughters moved to California in 1953 and has been a resident of Vallejo since 1956. Boots was a member of the Moose Lodge of Vallejo and an avid Giants and 49er fan. Most recently he was a resident of Merrill Gardens at North Bay where he enjoyed many friendships and activities.

Boots was preceded in death by his wife, Luella, his daughter, Patricia, his grandson Chad Kinney, as well as his parents, 3 brothers and 8 sisters.
