Jack Robert Lehman was born on March 14, 1961 to Ron & Marietta Lehman in Richmond, California and went to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus, on September 16, 2017 at the age of 56. He attended Kerry Hills Elementary, Pinole Jr. High and Pinole Valley High. As a young boy, he enjoyed playing Tara Hills baseball and loved to hunt and fish. Some of Jack's best memories from his youth were from the yearly trips to the Pitt River cabins and Burney Falls with his family.

In his high school years he was a part of two North Coast Section Championship football teams as a middle linebacker and captain of the defense. Jack continued his education and played football for Contra Costa College and Hayward State. He also enjoyed passing on his love of football as a linebacker coach for his alma mater, Pinole Valley High. After college, he worked in the Beer Industry and then eventually was hired at PG&E where he worked for the Gas department for over 20 years.

Jack was a very loving son, brother, uncle, cousin and friend to so many people. They all loved his warm and caring personality. He had a tender heart and a passion for helping others. Jack was a friend of Bill W. and was able to be clean & sober for 27 years, helping countless people along the way. He also had many pets in his life and loved them dearly.

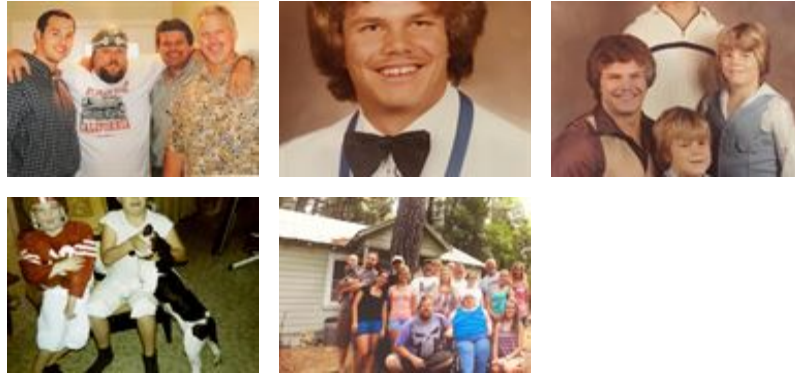
