John F. Flagg, 95, passed away Wednesday at his home in American Can-yon on natural causes.

Sargent Flagg was born in Westford, Massachusetts on 30 November 1921. He enlisted in the United States Army on 14 August 1942 and served as a Medical Technician, Heavy Machine Gunner, and as a Border Guard Pa-trolman, respectively, until 16 March 1946. On 10 February 1947 he reenlisted in the United States Army and served as a Medical Service Specialist until 17 September 1947. On 18 September 1947 he was intergrated into the United States Air Force and served as a Medical Service Technician until January 1964.

During his honorable service Sergeant Flagg has been awarded the following Awards and Decorations: Distinguished Unit Citation; Good Con-duct Medal with 5 Bonze Loops; American Campaign Medal; European-African-Middle East Campaign Medal; World War II Victory Medal; Army of Occu-pation Medal (Germany); National Defense Service Medal; Air Force Lon-gevity Service Award with 4 Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters.

As a noncommissioned officer in the United States Air Force Sergeant Flagg has demonstrated devotion to duty.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Merle Marie Flagg in 2015.

Survivors include his daughter, Shirlene Mireider; grandson, Julian Carrico; and great granddaughter, Natalie Carrico.

8th at Sacramento Valley VA National Cemetery, 5810 Midway Rd., Dixon.
