John P. Ford Sr., 95, passed away Thursday at Courtyard at Pine Creek Assisted Living in Concord.

John was born to Patrick and Mary Cadloni Ford on March 29, 1916 in Elmira, CA and was a longtime residence of Vallejo. He served in the Merchant Marines and worked as a pipe fitter on Mare Island Naval Shipyard for 27 years, retiring in 1971.

He enjoyed gardening, fishing, making wooden yard ornament windmills, and was a member of the American Legion Post 550. He and his late wife, Josie, often hosted many cocktail parties and dinners for family and friends, and their home was also the hangout for the neighborhood kids and his grandchildren, where the only shuffleboard tournaments for miles around were held.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Josephine on March 5, 1995.

Survivors include his daughters, Jeanne Wilkerson and Joan Jones; son, John P. Ford Jr.; sister, Agnes Campbell; brother, Bill; 6 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren.
