John Paul Perzigian, 88, passed away Wednesday, August 8 in Napa following a brief battle with colon cancer.

John was a longtime resident of the Vallejo and Benicia area, graduating from Vallejo High School in 1948. He served as a Navy Corpsman during the Korean Conflict, received his BA from San Diego State and his Master's in Special Education from Sacramento State.

John worked as a teacher for the Calaveras School District and several years for the Vallejo Unified School District, most recently at Franklin Junior High, retiring in 1997. He was a member of the Native Sons of the Golden West.

A funeral service will be held 11 AM Tuesday, August 14 at Twin Chapels Mortuary, 1100 Tennessee St., Vallejo. Burial will follow at All Souls Cemetery, Vallejo.
