Lulu Erna Luchsinger Fisk, 83, passed away in Santa Rosa on May 14, after a lengthy illness. Lulu was born on May 2, 1929 in Vallejo. She lived on York Street near the Luchsinger family, attended Vallejo schools, graduating from Vallejo High School. She received her diploma and teaching credential from San Jose State and returned to Vallejo to teach elementary school. Lulu was a loyal Vallejoan.

She married Les Fisk on July 6, 1952, and they had their four daughters. Lulu was actively involved in Lilac, PTA at Cooper Elementary School, PEO, the First Presbyterian Church as a deacon, member of the Session and Sunday School teacher, and Kappa Kappa Gamma. Lulu was a great support to her husband, daughters, mother, and in-laws.

Lulu's family was her greatest treasure and joy. She loved themed birthday parties, holidays, family trips to Dillon Beach, Pinecrest Lake and Carmel. She was an amazing daughter, mother and grandmother whose warmth and spirit endeared her to many. Even in her last years, she continued to make friends – even when her illness made communication difficult. Her pure heart and warmth were with her until the very end of her life.
