July 31, 1928 - December 29, 2023

Mary Jane Biama was born July 31, 1928, in Wichita, Kansas to the parents of Elva and Jim Whalen. Jim was a blacksmith and Elva a secretary. Times were hard the first few years. The family: Jim, Elva, older brother Jim and Mary Jane migrated to southern California where Mary Jane became friends with Shirley Temple.

Later the family migrated to Northern California to Benicia, where Mary Jane's younger brother: Pat was born. As World War II broke out, her father worked at Mare Island Naval Shipyard and her mother worked at Benicia Arsenal. Mary Jane graduated from Benicia High School in 1946. She attended Vallejo Junior College, while working at the Benicia Arsenal. Later she met a weapons inspector; Antonio Ricardo Biama. They dated for four years and were married in June 1950. They were married for 57 years until Dick Biama's death. Their married life started in Fresno, CA where their first son was born. They returned to Vallejo in 1952.

Mary Jane and Richard raised five children in Vallejo. She worked as a bookkeeper and teacher's aide. She volunteered at Kaiser Vallejo into her 80's, Mary Jane was loving, loyal, bright, strick and stubborn if challenged. Mary Jane is preceded in death by her parents; Jim and Elva, 1968 & 1973 respectively. Her brother Jim, 1975. Her son Charles "Chuck", 2005. Her husband Antonio Biama "Richard", 2007 and her son Steve, 2022.

She is survived by her brother Pat, 3 children: Rich, Dave and Gayle. She further survived by 5 grandchildren: Anthony, Bryan Christina, Brittany and

Mike. She also has 4 great grandchildren: Charlee, Gage, Kiara and Dylan.
