She also was a member of the Lilac Branch of the Oakland Children’s Hospital Auxiliary where she made many lifelong friends while raising funds for research and care of children. She also enjoyed walking with friends and later with her dog Molly on the waterfront. Mary was accomplished at knitting, loved reading and period piece movies.

Mary was an amazing mother, daughter and sister. She spoke to her daughters daily, had many traditions for the holidays and made sure everyone’s birthday included a favorite dinner with family. Mary and her sister and brother were very close and took wonderful care of their parents.

The favorite club Mary gained membership to in 1993 was the grandparent club. She attended plays, dance recitals, and many athletic events.
