Nicholas Joseph Lanza, 32, of Vacaville, California, unexpectedly passed away of a heart condition on Saturday, April 20, 2024.

He was born in Fairfield, California on December 22, 1991 to Ron and Janet Lanza. Nick attended Suisun Valley Elementary and Rodriguez High School before studying Plant and Soil Science at Chico State. After graduation, he worked as a grape grower for ten years. He most recently was the viticulturist at Komes + Garvey Ranches in Napa, a job where he found true purpose, pride, and enjoyment.

In 2017 Nick met the love of his life, Katie, at a mutual friend's party. The next morning they had their first date, which lasted all day. They were elated to be married on October 23, 2021 at Wooden Valley Winery. The two shared their home with their two pets, Aria and Mica, the second love of his life. Together they enjoyed kayaking and hiking, walking the dog, and cooking delicious meals.

Nick will always be remembered as the kindest person they knew. He was incredibly hard working, doing everything to the very highest of standards, but equally humble. Countless people will remember how he always looked for ways he could offer his help. He was a naturalist and outdoorsman who jokingly referred to himself as an "outdoor dog". He was a lifelong baseball player,
