On Sunday, July 7, 2024, Richard Craig Wittman, noble husband, and father, passed away at age 60 in Vallejo, California from Congestive Heart Failure. Craig was born on May 21, 1964, in Oakland, California to Richard and Ann (Hasenpusch) Wittman. He attended St. Basil Catholic School and graduated from St. Patrick High School in Vallejo.
