During his youth, he played Little League baseball with future MLB players, performed in the drama club/Scarlet Masque, and played high school football at Vallejo high school. He is a proud member of the Vallejo Sports Hall of Fame. After graduation he took a cross country adventure in a pickup truck with his friend Bill. He also did some cheerleading at Vallejo community college. He then began a career in construction that would lead to 37 years in the Laborers Union in which he held the role of Laborer, Business Agent, Business Manager and retiring as Director of the Training & Apprenticeship Center for Northern California. Robert was a man of faith; he was always active in church and doing things that honored the Lord. He helped establish an unwed mother's home, played Jesus in drama presentations, and helped establish a new church in the community. During retirement he helped his friend Sam build water wells for villages in Africa, traveled to Europe and Asia, attended SF Giants and 49er games with his friend Hank and watched his grandchildren play sports. Robert is survived by his 4 siblings Kenny (Sharon) Reynolds, Alan (Alana) Reynolds, Carol Lee and Mary Jo Reynolds. His 4 children Gwen (Matt)
