Dr. Roger A. Petrie, 51, passed away Tuesday at Sutter Solano Medical Center in Vallejo surrounded by his family.

Roger was born to Larry and Molly Petrie on February 12, 1964. He was a native and lifelong resident of Vallejo. He graduated from Hogan High School in 1982, UCLA in 1987 and Life Chiropractic College in 1989. He owned and operated Petrie Chiropractic in Vallejo the past 25 years.

Roger was an active member and pillar of our community. He was a member and former Director of the Vallejo Police Activities League, Vallejo Chamber of Commerce and Vallejo Rotary Club. He was a member of the Native Sons of the Golden West and supported or was affiliated with a great many worthy, local causes. He loved Vallejo. His “hobby” was being active and involved but most of all, he loved being with family and friends.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Herbert “Ace” Petrie, Dorothy Post and Mildred Thompson.

Survivors include his wife of 26 years, Debbie; daughters, Kelsey (Michael)

and Melissa (Zach); son, Nicholas; parents, Larry and Molly; sister, Shawna; brother, Mark (Lisa); nieces, Lacie, Marisa, Caylie and Gracie; and his nephew, Dallas.

I referred many clients to him, and also family friends throughout the years. He was very good to everyone, and took people right away. He taught me trigger point work, and he once drove up to the wine country after his own full day to put a very prominent wine maker's rib back in place. I always felt that Dr. Petrie was a ray of sunshine, happy to be with people and to help them live a healthy life. Just seeing him made me feel better, even before he did any treatment.*



I moved away from the Bay Area 2009, and relocated in South Lake Tahoe from Saint Helena, where I had lived for 15 years.

I did not find out that Dr. Petrie had died until April 19th, 2016, last week. I tried to let him know that Denis Malbec - age 46 - the man whose rib he put back in, had had a car crash a week ago Saturday, and died as a result. Dr. P had taken such extraordinary care of Denis - driving up to his home after his own full workday the same day he was called, and I thought his widow, May-Britt Malbec, would appreciate Dr. Petrie's concern during this painful time.

Unfortunately, when I googled to get the office phone number - his obituary came up instead, and I felt devastated because he was such a wonderful person, and too young. I do not know what the cause was, but I know his family and friends must have suffered greatly, and I am so apologetic of not having known until now. Maybe he greeted Denis Malbec into Heaven. I'd like to think so. What a happy welcome that would be!

My heartfelt wishes of belated condolences to his wife and children, and his parents if they are alive. I can't hardly look at his face without crying, but I just found out. Anyway I wish health and happiness to you all, Debbie and your children, who probably have

their own kids now. Your husband was a wonderful person. I'll miss Dr. Petrie forever.
