Rose Lee Seto, 86, died Monday at home following a long illness.

A native of Canton, China, Mrs. Seto, immigrated to the United States in 1948 via San Pedro. She had been a resident of Vallejo for the past 70 years. She grew up working at her parents' store, Lucky Sun Market. She attended Franklin Junior High and graduated from Vallejo Senior High, Class of 1954. Together with her husband, Fred, they owned and operated, Freddie's China Barn for 22 years from 1979 to 2001.

She was a member of the Vallejo-Napa Chinese Community Club and the Vallejo Chinese Christian Church.

Mrs. Seto is survived by her husband of 62 years, Fred Seto of Vallejo; son, Perry (Marian) of Orinda, daughter, Shirley Grace (Gregory) of Vallejo; son, Fred (Carla) of Vallejo; and daughter, Sophia Hall (Tad) of Novato; brother, Larry Lee of Vacaville; nine grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren.
