Roselyn Helen Wheeler was born November 13, 1942 in New Orleans, Louisiana, to Michael and Helen Curtis. At an early age the family moved to Los Angeles, CA where she resided with her parents. Roselyn attended Arlington Heights Elementary and Mt. Vernon Junior High, where she played the violin. Roselyn was very smart in school and appreciated being challenged in the spelling B's, math, reading, english, and history. Roselyn Graduated from Los Angeles High School. While attending L.A. City College she worked at Prudential and Allstate Insurance Companies. Majoring in Early Childhood Development, she pursued her Bachelor of Arts Degree and taught Elementary School in the City of Inglewood.
