



Rosendo Mailig Pillazar

March 1, 1937 - May 25, 2025

Rosendo Mailig Pillazar, a Vallejo, CA resident for 47 years, passed on Sunday, May 25, 2025 peacefully and in the comfort of his own home after a long battle with kidney and heart failure.

Born in San Piro, Balayan, Batangas on March 1, 1937 to Pedro Roxas Pillazar and Anicia Panganiban Mailig Pillazar. Rosendo was an excellent student, and he received his Diploma in Secretarial Science in 1957 from Immaculate Conception College in Balayan, Batangas. He then moved onto receive his Bachelor's of Science Degree in Commerce in 1965 from Far East University in Manila, Philippines. In 1967, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy and was stationed in San Diego, CA. Rosendo was eventually stationed in Mare Island Naval Shipyard, Vallejo, CA, and after 23 years, he retired as an E6 Disbursing Clerk. He continued employment as a civilian at Treasure Island, McLellan Airforce Base, and Presidio then finally retired in 2002.

Rosendo is survived by his wife Leticia of 56 years whom he met in 1965 in Calaca, Batangas, Philippines; two daughters: Rosalie and Rochelle; 5 grandchildren: Anjel, Alanah, Ronin, Eric Jr, and Roxy; 9 siblings: Margarita, Luceria, Corazon, Leodoro, Zenaida, Carmen, late Enriquito, Leticia, and late Caridad.
