Sally Jane Stone passed away at home on August 14th at the age of 55 following a three-year battle with cancer. She fought courageously, without complaint, never losing her faith or her positive outlook on life. Sally was born on November 7th, 1962 at Vallejo General Hospital. She attended Highland and St. Dominic's elementary schools, followed by Vallejo High School where she graduated 3rd in her class in 1980. After graduating high school, she continued her education graduating from Solano College Nursing School at the top of her class. After working numerous years helping others as a registered nurse, Sally returned to UC Davis to pursue her lifelong dream of becoming a teacher. Upon graduating she took a position as an elementary school teacher at St. Basil's School, where she taught for 19 years until she became ill.

She enjoyed traveling and spent a year living in Germany with her mother, Pat, and brother, Billy, when she was 19. Last year, Sally was blessed to travel back to Europe with her daughter, Ella, to Lourdes and visit her lifelong best friend, Rosanna Sanchez, in Italy. Every year, Sally and her family would spend a week in Lake Tahoe and she always looked forward to their annual stroll to the Stream Profile at the Taylor Creek Visitor Center. Sally shared her love of nature with her children, visiting many state parks to view every possible kind of tree in California, while pausing to read every informational sign in each park.

Sally will be remembered for her love of her children, her students, teaching, nursing, and her faith. She was a kind, caring, patient woman who will be deeply missed by those who knew and loved her.
