Shari loved this venture due to the whole family had a hand in the business and she was able to work with her family daily. She was a key player in R&J Honda Yamaha community service including bring The Ride for Kids (a ride for pediatric brain tumor research) to Solano County which has raised over 20 million dollars in the past 29 years.

From there, new opportunities to be of service presented itself. Sherie, volunteered at the Vallejo Police Department and help start the Vallejo Neighborhood Improvement Program where she was apart of the board for several years.

Sherie, had the opportunity in 2002 to work for Pace teaching art & sign language where she served for almost 20 years putting smiles on the face of all she came in contacted with.

If you asked what her most favorite & proudest accomplishments was; she would say being a Mom and "the best" being a Grandma. She loved just being whether it was a dance party's, tea party's, Legos, arts & crafts, fieldtrips, camping or quiet time (like watching a sunset) .
