



## Terry Joseph Martin Marcacci

July 7, 1969 - October 12, 2019

Terry Joseph Martin “T-Bone” Marcacci, 50, passed away suddenly on Saturday, October 12th at his home in Vallejo.

Terry was born to George Augustus Marcacci II and Ornella Zanaccimi on July 7, 1969 in Vallejo. He was raised in Benicia and graduated from Benicia High School in 1987. 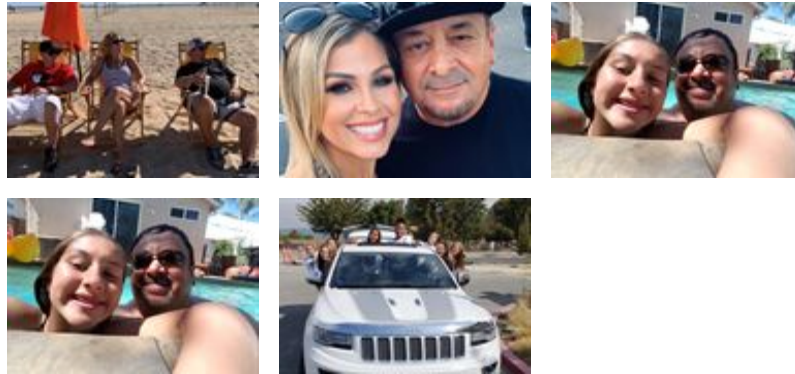
