Theodora Carmen Green, 90, passed away peacefully at her home on June 1, surrounded by her friends and family, following a brief illness. She was preceded in death by her husband, Frank L. Green; her sister, Helen Dill; and her brother, Seth (Bill) Jones.

Although she did not have children of her own, Carmen was a devoted and generous aunt and developed close and loving relationships with her nieces and nephews. Frank and Carmen were married 29 years when he passed away in 1984.

Carmen retired to the Camino Alto Residence Club in 1993 and resided there for 18 years. She came to feel very much at home at Camino Alto and appreciated the attentive care she received from staff that allowed her to continue to live her life on her own terms.

Carmen was set to rest at a private memorial service led by Rev. Al Marks, of the First Baptist Church in Vallejo, at Sunrise Memorial Cemetery on June 8, 2011. She will be remembered with love and deeply missed.
