Thomas James Cotter, 70, of El Salvador passed away Wednesday, April 3, 2024 peacefully of natural causes, surrounded by family in Vallejo California.

Tom was born December 15, 1953 in San Francisco at St. Joseph's Hospital, to Bill and Noreen Cotter. He was born to a traditional Irish family, being the 4th of 9 children. He attended Riordan High School, and graduated in 1972. Tom, along with his brothers Billy, Der and Barry played for 4 years in the Pearse and Connolly Fife and Drum Band, attending several St. Patrick's Day Parades in San Francisco.

After Tom graduated high school, joined the Army where he served for 7 years. He was honorably discharged as a Staff Sergeant in Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. Tom then went on to work for the city and county of San Francisco's bureau for water pollution control. He retired after 30 years as a chief engineer at the Oceanside Treatment plant.

In 1998 Tom met Reinita on a blind date in El Salvador. They went on to enjoy 26 years of love together. In March 2013 Tom and Reinita retired and moved to El Salvador, where he enjoyed spending his time reading, learning about history, watching documentaries, car auctions, and spending time with Hatchi, his beloved dog. He loved visiting California and going to his sister Eileen's Christmas Parties as well as spending time with his grandchildren.

He is survived by his wife Reina, brothers and sisters, Eithne, Eileen, Billy, Dermot, Barry, Brendan, Kevin and Terri, as well as his children, TJ, Tim, Maria and Juan and his grandchildren Robin, Everly, Lea, Sebastian, Santiago, Emilio and Joaquin.

Funeral services will be held at Twin Chapels Mortuary in Vallejo, California on Saturday April 20th, at 10:00am. A family and friends gathering will follow at 4:00pm at Dan and Eileen Gilman's house in Sonoma, CA.

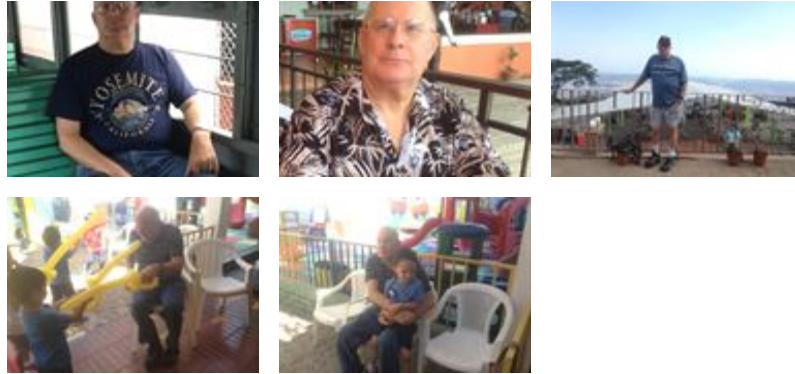
